

RESOLUTION NO. 20190909.2

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY,
FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF
THE ONE (1) YEAR FROM THE DATE OF THE
DECLARED EMERGENCY AS REQUIRED BY
ORDINANCE 2673 TO NOW BE TWENTY-FOUR
(24) MONTHS.**

WHEREAS, the City Commission adopted Ordinance 2673 on November 27, 2018, which allowed for the use of recreational vehicles, travel trailers, or trailers to be used as temporary emergency residential dwellings on private property or designated areas within the city based on a declared emergency issued by the City of Panama City Commission for no more than one (1) year from the date of the declared emergency unless the time is extended by a 4/5 vote of the Commission;

WHEREAS, Hurricane Michael caused mass destruction to a majority of residences and other dwellings in the city on October 10, 2018;

WHEREAS, the City of Panama City Commission declared a state of emergency in Resolution No. 20181009.1 in correlation with the Governor issued state of emergency first issued on October 7, 2018 in Executive Order 18-276;

WHEREAS, the Governor has extended that state of emergency every sixty (60) days and is still in effect as of today's date;

WHEREAS, the City of Panama City Commission will continue extending the state of emergency every seven (7) days as provided for in s. 252.38, Florida Statutes, until the Governor no longer has declared a state of emergency for Bay County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Panama City Commission has determined that there is a need to extend the one (1) year from the date of the declared emergency of Hurricane Michael to twenty-four (24) months as provided for in Ordinance 2673.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY
OF PANAMA CITY, FLORIDA**

SECTION 1. The City Commission of the City of Panama City does hereby find that the use of a recreational vehicle, travel trailer, or trailer as temporary emergency residential dwellings on private property or designated areas within the city is now allowed for no more than twenty-four (24) months from the date of the declared emergency, October 9, 2018.
