

RESOLUTION No. 20191008.1

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF PANAMA CITY, FLORIDA TO APPROVE HAZARD MITIGATION PROJECTS LISTED IN THE BAY COUNTY LOCAL MITIGATION STRATEGY (LMS) PLAN, AS AMENDED, AND APPROVAL OF THE TWENTY-FIVE PERCENT (25%) MATCH FOR THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM (HMGP) FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the City of Panama City, Florida is participating in a hazard mitigation planning process as established under the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Bay County Local Mitigation Strategy (LMS) Plan is a multi-jurisdictional hazard mitigation plan which encompasses Bay County, the Cities of Callaway, Lynn Haven, Mexico Beach, Panama City, Panama City Beach, Parker and Springfield; and

WHEREAS, the Bay County LMS Plan is updated on a yearly basis and after any major natural disaster event; and

WHEREAS, Hurricane Michael devastated Bay County and the surrounding area on October 10, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City of Panama City, is submitting project applications to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the State of Florida for potential grant funding and realizes that a twenty-five (25%) grant match must be met for each project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Panama City, has identified funding sources for the twenty-five percent (25%) matching funds for the projects listed below and is committed to providing the match whether in the form of funding or in kind contributions.
