**ITEM:** Consideration of acceptance of the BJA FY 19 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Award (# 2019-DJ-BX-0815) in the amount of \$22,860 and for a budget amendment in the same amount with accompanying Resolution #. This grant is 100% reimbursable; therefore, no matching funds are required. Resolution #20191022.2

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:** On September 25, 2019 the Panama City Police Department received notice from the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance (JAG) program that they had received an award under grant # 2019-DJ-BX-0815 for FY 2019 in the amount of \$22,860. This award will be used to purchase individual first aids kits (IFAK) and Automated External Defibrillators (AED's). This grant is 100% reimbursable; therefore, no matching funds are required.

**DEPARTMENT HEAD RECOMMENDATION:** Recommend that authorization be given to accept these funds and create a budget amendment in the amount of \$22,860 in the fiscal year 2019-2020 budget.
