## ITEM:

Consideration of authorization to accept a grant for FY 2019 in the amount of \$21,056.46 from the Department of Justice Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) program which is funded by a 50% match of federal forfeiture monies in the amount of \$10,528.23. A budget amendment in the amount of \$21,056.46 is also requested. This budget amendment will have an accompanying resolution # 20191022 . 3

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION: DEPARTMENT HEAD RECOMMENDATION:

The police department applied for and received a matching grant for FY 2019 in the amount of \$21,056.46 from the Department of Justice Bulletproof Vest Partnership (BVP) program. This grant requires a 50% match and those matching funds, in the amount of \$10,528.23, would come from federal forfeiture monies (Project #36). This award is to purchase National Institute of Justice (NIJ) compliant armored vests. Monies awarded must be expended no later than August 31, 2021. NIJ compliant vests have a 5-year expiration date from the date of manufacture. The Panama City Police Department, therefore, maintains a replacement schedule for expired armored vests in accordance with these standards. Each year the department applies for monies to help offset the replacement costs of these vests through the (BVP) program.

Recommend that authorization be given to accept this grant and create a budget amendment in the amount of \$21,056.46, which is funded by a 50% match of federal forfeiture monies in the amount of \$10,528.23. Further recommendation is for authorization to replace expired bulletproof vests with these dollars by purchasing replacement vests up to the total awarded of \$21,056.46 (account #55200). This budget amendment will also have an accompanying resolution # 20191022 . 3
