ITEM: Consideration of Hold Harmless Agreement with St. Andrews Historic Waterfront Partnership – Mardi Gras 2020.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The St. Andrews Historic Waterfront Partnership and its volunteers typically manages a City owned parcel as a parking lot during the St. Andrews Mardi Gras festivities and is requesting to do so this year (February 14th & 15th). Half of the dollars generated provide a stipend for volunteers and the other portion of funds from parking management will be donated to the St Andrews Historic Waterfront Partnership organization.

DEPARTMENT HEAD RECOMMENDATION: Staff recommends approval of the Limited Hold Harmless Agreement.

LIMITED HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

The City of Panama City agrees to protect, defend, indemnify St. Andrews Historic Waterfront Partnership (Organization) and hold the Organization and its officers, employees, sub-contractors and agents free and harmless from and against any and all losses, damages, or other expenses or liabilities of every kind and character arising out of and relating to the performance of managing the parking of the public during the Mardi Gras event being held on February 14th and 15th, 2020, so long as the actions taken by the Organization were reasonable and prudent under the circumstances. This Agreement only applies to property owned by the City and not to any property owned by a private person or entity.

Further, the Organization and any sub-contractors hired by the Organization agree to protect, defend, indemnify the City of Panama City and hold the City of Panama City and its officers, employees and agents free and harmless from and against any and all injuries (including injuries to its officers, employees, and agents), losses, damages, or other expenses or liabilities of every kind and character arising out of and relating to the performance of managing the parking of the public during the Mardi Gras event being held on February 14th and 15th, 2020.

This Agreement is in effect for February 14th and 15th, 2020. It will not be necessary for the Organization to contact City officials for permission so long as the actions taken are reasonable and prudent under the circumstances.
