

The Gateway Overlay is defined in two located within the City's Unified Land development Code. Each location is simply restated verbatim.

These locations are:

Sec. 104-66. - Gateway Overlay (GO) (Formerly known as the Tourist Corridor Overlay); and  
Sec. 105-4. - Gateway Overlay District (GO) Design Standards.

The definition is as follows:

B. District Defined. The GO District applies to non-residential land parcels of record within the City limits having frontage along the major roadways of U.S. Highway 98 / 15th Street; Harrison Avenue; Highway 368 / 23rd Street; Business U.S. Highway 98; Beck Ave; Highway 390; **and** Highway 77; **Baldwin Road and 3<sup>rd</sup> Street (from Sherman Avenue to Maine Avenue)**. The district **applies includes to** the property within 400 feet of the roadway (on each side of the road).
