

Ninth Amendment to the Public Works Memorandum of Understanding

WHEREAS, the Panama City Community Redevelopment Agency, Downtown North (“CRA District”), and the Panama City Public Works Department (“Public Works”) entered into a Memorandum of Understanding effective March 1, 2012, for the purpose of implementing the Cleanup and Abatement Program (CAP); and

WHEREAS, the MOU between the Panama City CRA and the Panama City Public Works Maintenance Division has been fulfilled per the original agreement; and the need for this service continues

WHEREAS, Section 3 of the MOU provides that the Alley Crew Program may be extended by written amendment or terminated as provided herein:

NOW THEREFORE, the Downtown North District and the Panama City Public Works Department express their mutual understandings and commitments as follows:

1. EXTENSION

This Ninth Amendment is retroactive commencing October 1, 2020, and terminating on September 30, 2021, unless extended by written amendment or terminated as provided herein.

2. FUNDING

SECTION 2: Funding

A. Funding for fiscal year 2020/2021 is \$100,000.

3. MOU

Except as modified by this Ninth Amendment to the MOU, the understandings and commitments contained in the original MOU remain as stated in the original MOU. This includes alleys and Right of Ways within the Downtown North District.

Public Works will maintain an inventory and maintenance log of all equipment purchased with funds under this agreement, this will be retroactive to the first year of operation. An inventory list will be submitted with the annual report with a start date of fiscal year 2020/21.

4. REPORTING

The department head shall submit a budget proposal detailing expenditures for all allocated dollars 30 days after approval of this MOU by the CRA Board. The department head receiving funds from the CRA shall submit quarterly and annual reports providing information regarding performance, services delivered, and quarterly/annual expenditures. If at all possible, project numbers should be established for convenient tracking expenses including capital expenditures.

This Ninth Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding on the Alley Crew Program (Public Works) is retroactive commencing October 1, 2020. The MOU is signed on ___ day of October, 2020.
